Documents for 2nd degree

The following documents are to be submitted upon enrolment:

• Application Form

The candidate fills in the application form containing, among others: his/her personal data and information about the chosen field of study, it should include a photo (size 492 x 633 px and size not exceed 2,5 MB, likewise photography 35 x 45 mm)

• BSc diploma or other document, confirming that applicant's BSc degree allows him/her to apply for admission to MSc studies at all universities in his/her country of origin

Additional documents:

- apostille or legalization of a document of international qualification, issued outside of Poland*
- decision on recognition of a document of international qualification, issued by the Polish Regional Board of Education (kurator oświaty) – if required
- sworn translation of all documents into Polish/ English if programme of study is in English
- Certificate of the language (Polish or English – if programme of study is in English) proficiency**
- power of attorney if a candidate is enrolled by a representative
- documents for minors if a candidate is under 18
- insurance proof

Upon enrolment in person, the candidate presents their identity document for inspection:

• passport (for non-European Union citizens) or ID card (for European Union citizens)

All the certificates and diplomas require legalization in the country of their origin. Documents issued in countries that are parties to the Hague Convention (the convention that abolishes the requirement of legalization for foreign public documents), must bear an Apostille
